There will be times with the Project Manager will also be the Project Installation Lead and will be required to travel to facilitate installation.

There is an expectation that Project Managers are problem solvers. Therefore, if a problem is seen and not addressed, the Project Manager is expected to inform the Senior Project Manager and Operations Manager verbally AND in writing of the issue and will include a solution.

- Participate in the bidding process.
 - Develop bids in ERP software.
 - Peer review bids
- Reviewing bid documents and asking questions from the bid team for clarity.
- Creating project schedules to adhere to the project budget and timeline.
- Creating a work breakdown structure with scale and scope within the project budget and timeline.
- Transparency in sharing all created schedules and documentation for assigned projects.
- Coordinate work assignments, including installation assignments, for Project Specialists, metal shop, carpentry shop, and paint shop with Senior Project Manager, Operations Manager, and Department Heads.
- Facilitate the development of project elements which may include, but are not limited to:
 - Drafting
 - Research
 - Proof of concept models
- Efficiently share project information with Project Specialists, Operations Managers, and Department Heads to facilitate their project assignments on budget and within schedule.
- Create and maintain project documentation for all information surrounding the project.
- Schedule and attend meetings between Scenic Solutions and the client to facilitate a smooth production process from imagination to reality.
 - Send drawings and proof of concept models for approval documentation.
 - Once a project moves into production, send progress photos weekly at a minimum.
